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During the Report Term, KVIE, Inc. engaged in the following long-term recruitment initiatives – some of which were impacted by COVID-19 and stay-at-home orders:

Completed long-term recruitment initiatives:

1. Volunteer program/community events to inform and educate members of the public as to employment opportunities in broadcasting:

KVIE offers diverse opportunities to the community for volunteer work to support its mission. Opportunities include answering donor calls, general office work, and event and production support. KVIE has hired some volunteers for employment in the past. Large-scale events in which KVIE was out in the community or the community could visit the station and used volunteers during the reporting period include:

- a. *KVIE Art Auction* various volunteer hours working with the Fundraising Events department, July 1, 2021 October 3, 2021
- b. *KVIE Golf Classic* June 14, 2022 (station personnel included teams from Fundraising Events, Sponsorship, Accounting, Donor Services, Marketing, Production, and Facilities departments along with the President and General Manager, Associate General Manager Operations, and the Human Resources Executive

2. Training programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills:

KVIE encourages employees to attend at least one training seminar each year within their specific job duties to improve their skills, help them qualify for a higher-level position and keep current with industry and job standards. KVIE provides at least one mandatory all-staff training session each year. During the reporting period, **all employees** received harassment and discrimination prevention training completed by June 1, 2022. During the reporting period, staff had access to ongoing online training opportunities for multiple fields of study. 3. Training to management level personnel as to methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and preventing discrimination:

- a. During the reporting period, all senior managers received harassment and discrimination prevention training on February 1, 2022.
- b. EEO Training: All hiring managers are trained by Human Resources to ensure equal employment opportunities are practiced during recruitment. Upon the beginning of the interview process for each position, Human Resources meets with the hiring manager to discuss standardized questions. Human Resources ensures EEO requirements and standards are met. Human Resources seeks a candidate pool with diversity before closing recruitment.

During the reporting period, the Human Resources Executive completed the following training and certifications as well as an ongoing monthly DEI meeting:

- i. Certificate in Diversity and Inclusion in HR Management, HRCI, November 2021
- ii. Leverage Diversity and Inclusion for Organizational Excellence, Stanford Graduate School of Business, January 2022
- iii. Attends a monthly DEI meeting with other PBS HR or DEI subject matter experts.
- c. During the reporting period, the President and General Manager and the CFO/Associate General Manager Operations attended and completed the Public Media Diversity Leaders Initiative (PMDLI) program of the Riley Institute at Furman University. The President and General Manager completed the program on December 9, 2021, and the CFO/Associate General Manager Operations completed the program on June 8, 2022.

4. Listing of Upper-Level Positions in Diverse Job Bank:

PBS KVIE posts positions, including upper-level positions, with diverse organizations that have substantial participation by women or minorities. For every full-time vacancy that PBS KVIE recruits, job postings are sent to various community groups and job banks representing a diverse population. PBS KVIE may hire recruiting firms should an upper-level position become available. Open-position notifications for the four full-time positions hired during the reporting period were given to diverse organizations:

- a. June 10, 2021* Donor Services Representative * hired in August 2021
- b. August 25, 2021 Broadcast Engineer
- c. September 17, 2021 Marketing Coordinator, Social Media
- d. January 25, 2022 Chief Sponsorship Manager

Job fairs:

The station typically attends in-person job fairs throughout the year. During the reporting period, KVIE did not participate in job fairs due to COVID-19 guidelines and restrictions.

Internship program:

KVIE continues to develop a comprehensive internship program and has established more productive



relationships with local colleges/universities. Past internships have also been available in Fundraising Events, Production, Finance, and Education. Most interns are students attending local universities and colleges, including the University of California, Davis; California State University, Sacramento; and Los Rios Community Colleges. *KVIE did not have interns during the reporting period due to COVID-19 guidelines and restrictions.*
